Topic: Kids in the Know Training
Participants: Elementary Health Teachers, Gr. 9 PE Teachers & Gr. 10 to 12 Religion Teachers
Time: 15 minutes
Format: Online Training

Description: Teachers will receive training on the Kids in the Know program, an evidence-based K–12 personal safety initiative aligned with Ontario’s Erin’s Law (Bill 123) and provincial curriculum expectations. The training focuses on the effective delivery of age-appropriate, trauma-informed lessons that promote student safety, well-being, healthy relationships, and responsible technology use. Educators are introduced to grade-specific content, teaching strategies, and comprehensive classroom resources that support key learning outcomes in health and physical education, social-emotional learning, and digital literacy. Through this training, teachers learn how to integrate topics such as personal safety, consent, and online responsibility into everyday instruction, helping them meet mandated expectations while reinforcing key safety concepts in developmentally appropriate and meaningful ways.
